

KOSSUTH COUNTY REPUBLICAN CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES JUNE 21, 2021

The Kossuth County Republican Central Committee met Monday, June 21, 2021, at the Thul Shed, with 18 people in attendance. Chairperson, Carter Nath, welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 7:07 p.m. Ray Neswold opened the meeting with prayer and then Carter led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Carter then reported on results of the June 19 5K Fundraiser: it went well and approx.. 45-50 people participated. A formal report of the exact amount of money raised will be provided at the July meeting, but it is estimated that the amount is \$200-\$300.

- 5. Burt Town Celebration, July 10, 1 p.m.
- 6. LuVerne Community Celebration, July 10, 2 p.m.
- 7. Kossuth County Fair, August 3, 6 p.m.
- 8. Algona Band Day, October 2, 1 p.m.

Carter will contact Bancroft and Burt regarding details to enter the float in their parades.

Organizers for the Kossuth County Fair contacted Carter and he told them that the Kossuth County Republicans will sponsor a booth for the Fair. Roger Tjarks offered a motion to pay the \$200 fee for a booth at the Kossuth County Fair, Eldon Jorgenson seconded the motion and it passed.

Carter then announced the following:

- 1. State Senator, Jim Carlin, will attend the next meeting of this group. He will be a candidate for the U.S. Senate from Iowa.
- 2. The Franklin County Republicans are sponsoring Steve Deace in a "Stand Up For Spoken Truth!" event on Monday, June 28, 7 p.m., at the Franklin County Convention Center.
- The Family Leadership Summit will be Friday, July 16, at the Community Choice Credit Union Convention Center, Des Moines. Speakers include: Gov. Kristi Noem, former Vice-President Mike Pence, Mike Pompeo, Ken Starr, Steve Deace, Joel Rosenberg, Michael Youssef, Bob Vander Plaats. For more information visit their website, thefamilyleader.com.
- 4. Senator Grassley will have a town meeting at the Kossuth County Election Center, 108 S. Hall St., Algona, on June 29, 2-3 p.m.

Carter stated that he will be running for County Supervisor from his district in 2022. If he is elected, he will no longer serve as chairperson of this group. People should be thinking of good candidates for chairperson so there is time for Carter to train someone.

Carter then introduced State Representative, Henry Stone, who provided a synopsis of what was accomplished during this year's legislative session including: a pro-life constitutional amendment, two gun bills, two election bills, a vaccine passport bill, eliminating the death tax. He also stressed the importance of electing conservative Republicans to the State House and State Senate.
