

KOSSUTH COUNTY REPUBLICAN CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES JULY 26, 2021

The Kossuth County Republican Central Committee met Monday, July 26, 2021, at the Thul Shed, with 16 people in attendance. Chairperson, Carter Nath, welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 6:28 p.m. Ray Neswold opened the meeting with prayer and then Carter led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Carter then led discussion on the NationBuilder program, a platform offered by the Republican Party of Iowa, to help local Republican organizations with fundraising, communication, etc. Before making a decision to participate in this program, the general consensus was that more information is needed. Carter will invite George Anderson to a future meeting for further education on this topic.

Carter introduced State Senator, Dennis Guth, who stated that 300-500 people attended the nationwide Freedom Rally in Des Moines on Saturday, July 24. He also stated that a group of legislators are working on legislation to insure the citizens' freedom regarding certain mandates, but this will take time. Everyone is invited to contact Gov.
