



KOSSUTH COUNTY REPUBLICAN CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES
SEPTEMBER 27, 2021

The Kossuth County Republican Central Committee met Monday, September 27, 2021, at the Thul Shed, with 14 people in attendance. Co-Chairperson, Carter Nath, welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 7 p.m. Todd Hartsock opened the meeting with prayer followed by everyone reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Regarding the minutes of the August meeting, Ken Clark stated that the following sentences were out of order: "Wendell Steven offered a motion to nominate Dr. Brent Owen for chairperson, Eldon Jorgenson seconded the nomination and the vote is on hold until Dr. Brent Owen accepts the nomination." A motion for officer nomination cannot be made without the Central Committee receiving five days notice of this intent and five days notice was not provided. Ken Clark then offered a motion to approve the minutes of the August meeting as amended, Bobbie Clark seconded the motion and it carried.

Carter then introduced State Representative Henry Stone. Henry advised the group that the Iowa legislature will be convening next week and voting on redistricting on Tuesday, October 5. He also stated that many people have been contacting him regarding vaccine mandates and wondering if the legislature could address this topic on October 5 as well. Algona Band Day will be Saturday, October 2, with the parade beginning at 1 p.m. and line-up at noon. Carter reported that the Republican float is Entry #51 and people are needed to walk alongside. Carter will insure there is a driver for the float.

The date for the 2022 Kossuth County Republican caucus is February 7, 2022, 7 p.m. Stacy Besch has reserved the Burt gym as the location for all Kossuth County precincts. Carter needs to know by October 31 who will be volunteering that night. Todd Hartsock and Kim Schenk Hartsock and Pastor Colin Andrade volunteered to help that night.

Carter then reported that a Rally for Donald Trump will take place Saturday, October 9, 7 p.m., at the Iowa State Fairgrounds. Doors will open at 2 p.m.

Sunday, October 10, 4 p.m., there will be a fundraiser for U.S. Senate candidate, Jim Carlin, at the Dr. Brent and Hilah Owen home, 2420 River Road, Algona. Invite friends, family, and neighbors.

The next Patriots Meeting will take place Monday, October 11, at 7:17 p.m.
