

KOSSUTH COUNTY REPUBLICAN CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES MARCH 22, 2021

The Kossuth County Republican Central Committee met Monday, March 22, 2021, at the Pizza Ranch, with 20 people in attendance and some via Zoom. Chairperson, Carter Nath, welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. Todd Hartsock opened the meeting with prayer and then Carter led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Carter then reported on plans for the upcoming 5K Fundraiser:

- The theme for the run and the logo on the t-shirt is "Let Freedom Run". Caley Nath has designed the t-shirt and registration forms and advertising flyers. She will check out the possibility of having blue t-shirts rather than gray.
- The date for the run is Saturday, June 19, beginning at 8 a.m.
- Starting and ending point will be the YMCA. The bike trail and some city roads will be used. Carter has contacted Kendall Pals regarding the route and Carter will contact the mayor to obtain necessary authorizations.
- Carter and Caley will organize the printing of advertising flyers and distributing them around the county.
- Fareway and Hy-Vee will be contacted for possible donations of water and bananas.
- The committee will insure that an EMT or medic is present during the race.
- Each finisher will receive a t-shirt and there will be a small prize/medal for top 3 male and female finishers in the various age groups.
- It was suggested that information regarding the Republican party could be exhibited in the registration area.
- Sponsors could be recruited to advertise on t-shirts and/or signs on the route.

There are still sixteen openings on the Central Committee from various precincts. Everyone is to help think of possible candidates to fill these openings. The April meeting agenda will include nominating people to fill the empty Central Committee positions.

Carter mentioned that State Senator Dennis Guth had contacted him regarding a possible Kossuth County house party for State Senator Jim Carlin who has announced he will be running for U.S. Senator Chuck Grassley's seat in 2022.
